WHAT *TO* BRING & WHAT *NOT* TO BRING

What we have...

All bedrooms:

Each bedroom contains a single bed base with a mattress, desk, wardrobe/closet, bar fridge, telephone for internal use, carpet, curtains, mirror, chair, towel rail, waste paper bin, mattress protector, two towels, two blankets, two sheets, pillow and pillow case, bed cover, fluorescent lighting and seasonal heating/cooling.

Room compendium or information folder.

Upgraded bedroom:

All of the above, TV and clock radio.

Kitchens:

One large kitchen and one small kitchen on each floor.

Each kitchen has hotplates, microwave, toaster, hot water unit or kettle; some floors have a full-size fridge in the main kitchen only.

Toilet and Shower facilities:

Are located on each floor; male, female and unisex.

Laundry:

Located on each floor, washing machine and dryer are available at a small cost. Clothes airer, iron and ironing board are provided free of charge.

Study room:

Located on each floor with desk and chairs provided.

Lounge & Dining Rooms:

Each floor has lounge and dining facilities which includes couches, table and chairs and a TV.

Common Room – Basement:

Table Tennis table, TV with DVD unit, CD player, couches, assorted DVD's and books.

Communications & Vending machines:

Public telephone and vending machines located in main foyer area.

WHAT **TO** BRING & WHAT **NOT** TO BRING

What to bring:

Many of these items are of course, optional and will depend on personal preferences

- Toiletries and toiletry tote basket
- Thongs for the bathroom
- Laundry hamper/basket and washing powder
- Drying rack for washed clothes (optional as TVIR does supply a few)
- Coat hangers
- Personal items, clothing, photos etc
- Grooming equipment
- Personal television (supplied in common areas and upgraded room. Not all floors have TV aerials), DVD player, computer, camera etc
- Cooking utensils, pots pans, crockery and cutlery
- Storage box for food items and kitchenware
- Favourite quilt, mattress topper or pillow (TVIR supplies Linen but you may prefer your own)
- Alarm clock (supplied in upgraded room)
- Power board with cut off switches-Australian standard (in case you have a number of electrical appliances)
- Power adaptor (Australian standard)
- Pedestal fan for summer
- Bike (bike rack provided in basement)

What not to bring:

- Blow heaters, bar heaters, electric blankets
- Microwaves, toasters, kettles (these are supplied in the kitchen)
- Home brew kits, illegal substances or firearms
- Chemicals and poisons
- Pets
- Candles, incense or oil burners
- Open flame devices
- Double adaptors or extension cords
- Electrical equipment in disrepair or too aged to pass security standards – e.g., frayed cords, bare wires or appliances that are not at Australian standards

WHAT **TO** BRING & WHAT **NOT** TO BRING

Things you can bring if you feel you need them but cannot be used in your room – only in the kitchens. These items *must* be checked and tagged by TVIR maintenance and must not be left unattended while in use.

- Toasted sandwich maker or electric grill
- Rice cooker
- Blenders, food processor
- Electric wok or frypan
- Airfryer
- Slow Cooker
- Coffee Maker

Please note that nebulisers and other breathing equipment are medical items that you can use in your room but we would appreciate being notified that you have them onsite.
